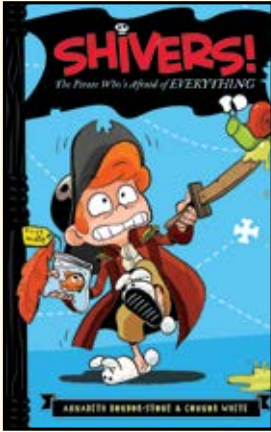


PIRATE TRADING CARDS



“Pirate Battle”

Create 10 brand new pirates and number them 1-10 (from least to most fierce). Now, it's time to battle!

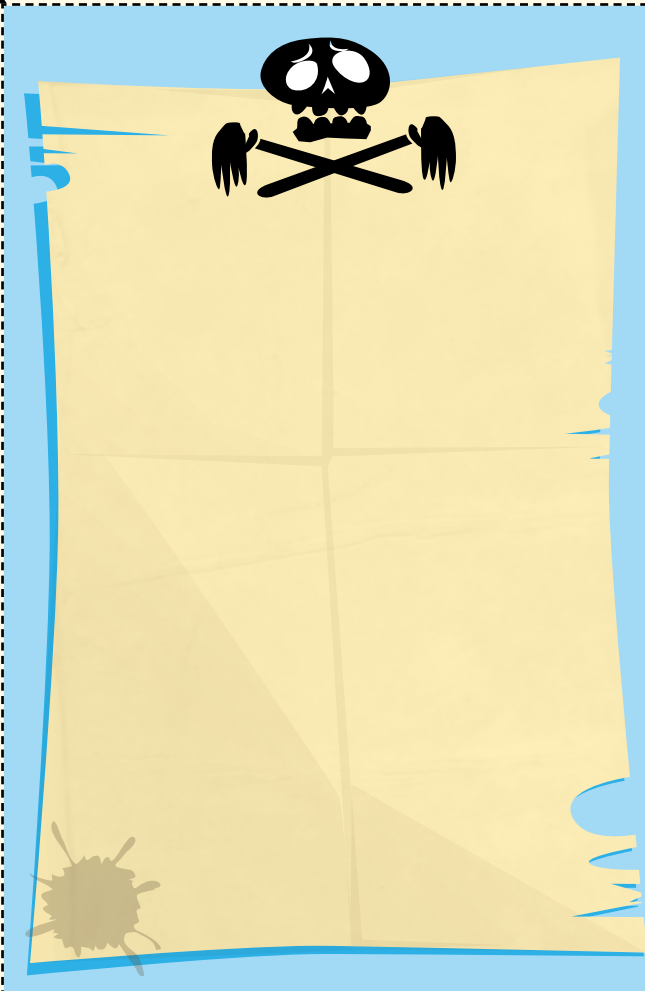
Each player picks a card from the top of his or her shuffled deck. The higher number wins each battle!

If there is a tie, you must take the next two cards from your pile and add all three numbers up. The winner of each battle takes all the cards from that battle and puts them at the bottom of his or her pile.

The game is over when one person has all of the cards.
